Set up camp. Explore the park with a simple hike on Emory Gap Trail, a 2.5 mile moderately trafficked out and back trail featuring a waterfall and good for all skill levels. End the evening with a marshmallow roast.





Drive to nearby **Historic Rugby.** Pick up a picnic lunch at the RM Brooks Store. Enter the **Big South Fork National River and Recreation Area** from downtown Rugby. Hike to Gentleman's Swimming Hole, unpack your picnic lunch, and enjoy a refreshing dip in the crystal clear waters. Hike back out and head to **Obed Wild and Scenic River** for some amazing photo opportunities. Stop by the Hops Lily Pad for a pint of locally brewed beer and a snack. If you can stay to dark, Obed is one of the International Dark Sky Parks in America and only the second east of the Mississippi. Head back to camp.





 Wake up early and go birding along Flat Creek. Frozen Head is a part of the Southern Cumberland Mountains Important Bird Area. Head back to camp for a hearty breakfast. Breakdown and make plans to come again.
