Check In Take a late afternoon hike at the **Pistol Creek Wetland Center** near Maryville College in Maryville. Pick up dinner or select a restaurant to enjoy a meal. Some popular local stops are **Hot Rods 50's Diner** and **Foothills Milling**. Head home and rest up for a day of exploring.

Townsend Historical Trail - Savor your coffee and lace up your boots. You will be heading to beautiful **Townsend** along the Tellico River. This area has a rich history of logging and Appalachia arts. Be sure to stop at other points of interest such are the Great Smoky Mountains Heritage Center and the Little River Railroad and Lumber Company **Museum**. Finish the day with a late lunch stop at **The Abbey**, a local family friendly craft beer and cidery dining establishment along the river. Head back to your cabin. Have the group help prepare simple meal (who doesn't love a home cooked meal!) followed by an evening of family time replete with popcorn and mugs of cocoa in front of a toasty fire. Read, play games, or simply step outside to see the night stars. Use an app to identify constellations.
