Cherokee Lake is one of the nine lakes in the region. With a water surface of almost **29,000 acres** dotted with islands, the TVA reservoir is a popular destination for **fishing**, **boating**, and paddling.

Set up camp. Great options include Panther Creek State Park, Cherokee Lake Campground (dam) or one of the many TVA islands. Island camping is primitive, but requires no reservation or fees. Simply boat out and set up. Leave No Trace Principles are enforced. Take a hike across Cherokee Dam for some of the most amazing sunset photos.





Head out for a **day on the lake**. Boats and kayaks can be rented nearby. Or bring your own watercraft and launch from a public ramp. **Paddle, and cruise** the scenic waterway. Pack a lunch and your binoculars. Over **125 species of birds** have been observed including osprey, eagles, blue heron, turkey, and wintering waterfowl. Head back to camp and make a meal.
